In order to guarantee your safety when visiting the fair and in compliance with the regulations in force pertaining to COVID-19 prevention, Padova Hall would like to inform you that your body temperature will be measured at all car and foot entrances to the fair and access will be denied to people with a temperature of 37.5°C or higher. In addition, for the sole purpose of traceability required by the provisions in force, a register containing the contact details of all people present will be kept for 14 days. The data above will be processed according to the information that follows.

This data processing is carried out exclusively to prevent COVID-19 contagion; in compliance with the regulation protocol in place, Padova Hall will measure all people's body temperature upon entering the premises, but will not record any temperature measurements. Access to the premises will be denied to people with a temperature of 37.5°C or higher. In these cases, the person will be informed of the circumstances and will be asked to read the guidelines provided by the Ministry of Health for COVID-19.

Personal data categories: within the limits of the purposes and data processing methods defined herein, the following information will be subject to processing - first name, surname, country of origin, phone number. People whose personal data will be processed are: collaborators, visitors, clients and any other third parties with access to the Padova Hall premises.

Nature of the data provision: providing data is compulsory. Refusal to provide data will result in denial of access to the premises.

Legal basis: the legal basis of the processing is provided by general protection principles and well-being in the workplace and the implementation of the anti-contagion safety protocols in accordance with art.1 no.7 letter d) of DPCM 11/03/20 and subsequent amendments in agreement with the regulation protocol adopted by Padova Hall.

Personal data recipients: the data will not be shared or disclosed to third parties unless for specific legal reasons (e.g. if requested by the Health Authority to reconstruct the timeline of any close contacts of a person who results positive to COVID-19).

Transferability of data to third countries: Personal data will not be shared with countries outside the European Community.

Data conservation period: The personal data collected will be kept for maximum 14 days from the issue date; once this timeframe expires, all data will be destroyed with the exception of data that is to be kept for further reasons for specific events and/or circumstances (for example, requested on behalf of Authorities/public bodies, including those designated for health and safety inspections).

Rights of the person concerned: The person concerned has rights in accordance with article 15 and subsequent articles of EU Regulation 2016.679, and can enforce these by writing directly to Padova Hall - see the contact details above. More specifically, said person has the right, at any moment, to obtain access to personal data and request information pertaining to processing and limiting processing

on behalf of the Processing Manager. If the person concerned believes that the personal data processing carried out by the Data Processor is happening in violation of what is set forth by the GDPR, the person concerned has the right to file a complaint to the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data (<https://www.garanteprivacy.it/>).

Amendments to the information: Padova Hall may change, amend, add or remove any part of this Privacy Information document at any moment, unless consent is required.
